

**1)** In the fields "Title" and "Author" there are three ways of doing the search:

- For exact queries, use quotation marks

*example:* "Walnut management for valuable timber production"

- For queries including different words write " +" (with a space on the left, without space on the right)

*example:* +cherry +silviculture

- In the case of not writing " +", every result that includes any of the words will be shown

**2)** The search engine does not take into account accents (example: à=a).

**3)** For doing a search for publications of a given year (example: 2005), it must be written in both "since" and "to"

*example:* since 2005 to 2005

When writing 2005 in the field "since" only, the results will include any reference from 2005 and newer.

**4)** In the field "Source" the exact wording must be written, without quotation marks or " +".

**5)** In the drop-down menus, more than one option can be selected by pressing key "ctrl".
